Schultz Swan and Unicorn Sauvignon Blanc

RSA
Elgin
Fragrant citrus with subtle tropical undertones on the nose which follow through to a lovely long mineral finish on the palate. Fresh, crisp and vibrant. Great for an aperitif but will pair well with light fish or chicken dishes

Stellenbosch Hills Polkadraai Chenin Sauvignon

Star bright with a green undertone. An easy to drink, well balanced blend. The wine is grassy on the nose, but the tropical fruit flavours come through on the palate. Al fresco lunches, cold cucumber soup, sushi and grilled chicken.

De wetshof Bon Vallon Chardonnay

Soils rich in limestone and broken mountain rock on De Wetshof's site-specific vineyards allow this wine to emit optimum varietal expression. An unwooded wine, Bon Vallon has a brisk and clean freshness leading into a wide spectrum of classic flavours including citrus, wild flowers and grilled nuts, with a nuanced minerality on the aftertaste.

Glenelly Estate Reserve Chardonnay

The Estate Reserve Chardonnay displays a wonderful bright crisp colour. The nose displays vibrant citrus, lime zest & flint with hints of apple and vanilla butterscotch. The palate is lush, the creamy texture is underpinned with beautiful mineral notes and hints of toasted almond and vanilla. The finish is fresh with great minerality and has a nervous energy about it.

Springfield Miss Lucy, Sauvignon Blanc, Semillon and Pinot Gris

Miss Lucy is one of the seven nicknames given to the Red Stumpnose by the fisherman of the Southern Cape. Like many other marine species, the Miss Lucy has been over-exploited and is now critically endangered. Created as an ode to the bounty of the sea, Miss Lucy can turn the many other delights safe to grace our tables, into a celebration of the ocean. Only a salty breeze and a sunny day can improve what is already a perfect match. This unique blend of Sauvignon Blanc, Semillon and Pinot Gris bursts with citrus pamplemousse flavours and an ample mouth feel, yet remarkably moderate in alcohol.

Simonsig Die Grapesmith Kluisenaar

With a light golden hue, Die Kluisenaar entices with aromas of acacia and lemon tart, baked apple and hints of lightly toasted nuts. A rich and well-structured palate with a silky texture. Well defined acidity is complimented by an inkling of minerality and a lingering finish.

Babylonstoren Mourvedre Rose

An elegant dry wine of a sophisticated salmon colour and delicious hints of strawberries and rose petals. A sip leads to a delightful discovery of creamy strawberry yoghurt, the sweet airiness of candy floss and a subtle punch of acidity.

De Grendel Rose

Pale rose gold in colour, with a pronounced bouquet of watermelon, raspberry coulis and passion fruit. The palate is dry with a medium acidity, packed with red berry flavours, floral undertones and a crisp citrus tail. De Grendel Rosé is the ideal partner for lighter summer fare such as spicy prawns, Portuguese sardines and salads made with red fruits such as watermelon, raspberries, strawberries and pomegranate. A dry, perfumed and fruity rosé that is perfect for easy sipping on a sweltering day.

Paul Cluver Village Pinot Not

Beautiful aromas of red fruits intermingle with roasted spices followed by a delicious, elegant silky palate of poached ripe plums resulting in medium bodied wine with soft edges. Crafted for drinking now, it has the structure and fruit to be enjoyed for two years and beyond. Serve with rosemary and mustard infused lamb. Asian style fish dishes or vegetarian lentil burgers.

Intense cherry and turkish delight aromas. Light in hue and alcohol with delicate tannins yet full of flavour, layered fruit, fresh acidity and a savoury element.

Rustenberg Grenache

In its youth the wine exhibits very attractive red fruit flavours, such as strawberry and cherry, along with a wonderful pepper spice. As the wine ages it will reveal a more savoury fruit profile.

Vinologists Swartland Syrah

The intense nose is upfront, savoury and perfumey and entices with its abundance of violets, dark plums, rich brambles, cranberry, exotic spice and slight garrigue character. The violets and red fruit of the nose follows through onto a full, fleshy mid-palate with flavours of youngberry, blueberry and blackberry and notes of vanilla, cloves, nutmeg and candied orange peel. The wine is robust, yet smooth and richly textured. It shows exceptional balance with vibrant, yet integrated acidity. The wine ends with hints of sweet spice lingering on its focused finish.

Le Riche Richesse

Aromas of fresh plums and red cherries, balanced with a touch of oak on the nose. Juicy mouth filling flavours of red berries are supported by a fine, silky tannin structure and a rounded long finish.

Waterford Cabernet Sauvignon

Pure fruit and earthy notes complimented by a classical pencil lead aroma. A typical dry tannin structure with seamless balance to finish.

Silverthorn's Green Man

Fresh aromas of green apple and acacia blossom backed up by subtle hints of minerality and whiffs of freshly baked brioche. Well balanced with an elegant structure, fine mousse which imparts a gentle explosion of bubbles on the palate and a long finish.

Wildekrans MCC brut

A fragrant nose of green apple, hints of orange peel and roasted almonds. The palate offers a fresh, citrusy mouthfeel with lingering taste of shortbread on the finish. An elegant and crisp mousse enhances the freshness of this wine.

Miss Molly Pink MCC

The Miss Molly Bubbly aroma has highlights of citrus – specifically lemon and lime – with a hint of pineapple. This is all supported by biscuity and yeasty undertones. ... The citrus and yeasty aromas carry through from the nose to the palate, making for a refreshing finish.

Misterio Malbec 2017

ARGENTINA

Mendoza Argentina

Dark ruby in colour, the nose shows aromas of dark berry, toasted vanilla and oak spices. It is medium-bodied, fruity and toasty

Misterio Shiraz 2012

ARGENTINA

Mendoza Argentina

Deep violet in color. Red fruits from the forest (blackberries and raspberries) combined with spices and liquorice. Medium body with sweet tannins.

Misterio Chardonnay 2018

ARGENTINA

Mendoza Argentina

Lemon colour with golden sparkles. Aroma of green apple and linden flower. Predominant flavour of white fruit with a long finish.

Los Boldos Sauvignon Blanc 2017

CHILE

Cachapoal Chile

Pale yellow, with greenish shades. Fresh citric aromas and orange blossom. Fruity and fresh, with a vibrant acidity and a pleasant ending.

Los Boldos Syrah 2012

CHILE

Cachapoal Chile

A deep, dark red wine, with aromas of ripe red fruits and spiced notes of black pepper and tobacco. On the palate, this wine is balanced and spicy with velvety tannins and a soft, fruity finish.

Los Boldos Merlot 2015

CHILE

This Merlot Tradition is characterized by an intense ruby red color. In the nose very powerful notes of plum and red fruits appear. In the mouth plum predominates. Silky tannins and good acidity wine. It is a wine with a nice aromatic persistence and with a perfect balance between acidity / alcohol and tannins.

Los Boldos Cabernet Sauvignon 2014

CHILE

This Cabernet Tradition has a very deep dark red colour. The nose is powerful with red fruits, mint and a slight touch of spices dominate. The mouth is elegant, with fresh tannins melted. It also has an attractive concentration and good presence.

LAN Crianza 2015

Intense red cherry colour. Aromas of red fruits, strawberry, raspberry and cranberry framed by fine nuances of vanilla and toffee. Silky and structured on the palate, it has a long lasting and satisfying finish.

LAN – D12 Single Vineyard 2012

Lan D-12 is a 100% Tempranillo produced from the best grapes from the vineyards located in the estate "Viña Lanciano". elegant. Notes of liquorice, spices, and roasted coffee and cocoa are all well integrated. In the mouth, fleshy and silky.

Mateus Brut Rose NV

PORTUGAL

Mateus Rosé Sparkling Brut has a beautiful, pale, rose petal pink colour, with light hues of salmon. The copious bubbles are extremely fine and the resulting delicate mousse, persistent. Refined and crisp with floral nuances, this wine has pleasing aromas of apples, pears and raspberries and subtle notes of toasted bread which interplay with a fresh and lively acidity, providing an aromatic and delicate finish.

Vinho Verde

Presents a pale citrine color. This is a smooth and fresh wine with a delicate and fruity aroma, young and balanced. A crisp white, with fresh-cut apple flavours that are supported by juicy citrus notes. Shows hints of peach on the finish.

Mariana White 2017

Alentejo Portugal

Medium-bodied and lightly aromatic. This lovely white offers hints of flowery notes, citrus, pear, melon with a smooth mouthfeel finish. Overall easy drinking, uncomplicated style. Perfect for drinking without thinking.

Mariana Rose 2018

Medium-bodied, dry. Red, blue, and black berries on the nose and palate, with a finish of earth, good tannic structure, and balanced acidity. Pair with grilled burgers and sausages, meat pizza, and stews.

Mariana Red 2018

Colour is Ruby red and a bouquet floral and fruity with hints of fresh morello cherry, spices and black cherry. On the palate refreshing and soft

JP Tinto

Setubal Portugal

From the Palmela region of Portugal's Setubal Peninsula, this is a popular and well-made blend. Flavours of cherry, strawberry and blackberry are supported by a supple tannic structure. Excellent value and an ideal partner for grilled chicken, pork with clams or cured meats

Casa Ferreirinha Vinha Grande Tinto 2016

PORTUGAL

DOURO Portugal

Deep ruby colour and the aroma is intense and complex, with floral and violet notes, together with red fruits such as strawberry and raspberry, a touch of black pepper and very well integrated oak. On the palate, it has good volume, well integrated acidity, velvety tannins with notes of red fruits, and a delicate minerality. Its finish is elegant and persistent.
